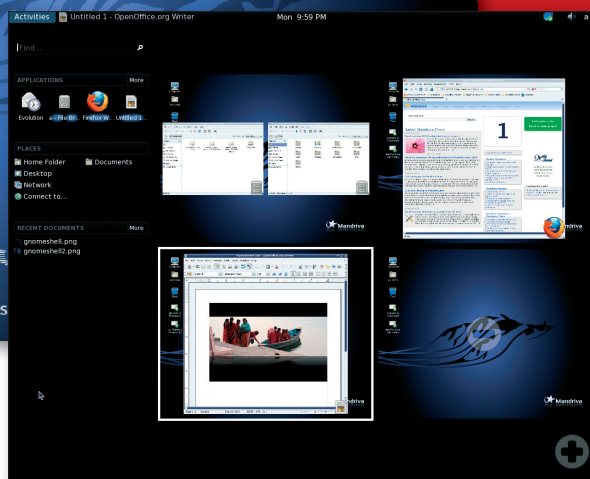

The Mandriva Free edition is free of any proprietary drivers or codecs.

DOUBLE-SIDED DVD

This DVD is a double-sided disc. A DVD device always reads the side of the disc that is facing down. This DVD is labeled like a normal DVD – the label you see as you place the disc into the tray applies to the data on the opposite side. If you are installing Mandriva, the Mandriva label should be facing up in the tray.
