


On the DVD

Other enhancements include updates to Evolution, the Ubuntu One music manager, and the Gwibber social networking app. A Live boot option lets you try the disc with no risk to your existing configuration.



BackTrack 4 R1

This special security distro comes with an arsenal of useful tools for penetration testing and security assessment. Best-of-breed utilities for pen testing, network mapping, privilege escalation, digital forensics, and other critical security tasks are organized in a handy menu system for easy access from a bootable DVD.

DOUBLE-SIDED DVD

This DVD is a double-sided disc. A DVD device always reads the side of the disc that is facing down. This DVD is labeled conventionally – the label you see as you place the disc into the tray applies to the data on the opposite side. If you are installing Ubuntu, the Ubuntu label should be facing up in the tray.
